Podcast Highlights

- There's a difference between knowing about love languages and having it revolutionize you.
- Love languages don't come naturally...early on it's easy to become resentful.
- When you try to do something that doesn't come naturally it won't be easy and the chance that you'll fail is greater. It's hard and takes persistence.
- Love is what you do for someone else based on her requirements and standards.
- Love maps: Pages of notes on your most important "customer"...your wife...her loves, likes, dislikes, cares and needs based on her life story. Favorite foods, places, movies, key dates...
- Our job is to keep our wife's "love tank" as full as possible. Constantly fill it...keep it as high as possible.
- It's our job as husbands to lead the charge in love languages.
